Financial update - Mona - work on the projected budget for 26/27 is not yet complete. Mona will email the budget to the board next week. The board can raise any concerns via email. The finalized budget will be presented at the annual CAG meeting in June.

Sales – Pat - successful Mother's Day weekend sale \$13,536 total with \$2173 for CAG. CAG ware sales go directly to scholarships. The 15% from goes to the general fund. Note that proceeds from Chili Bowl tickets and HHS Kid's table sales also go directly to scholarships.

Art & Wine - tables full - everyone gets ½ table.

Membership update – Erika – 2 new for summer. We will send notification for fall sign ups on July 1.

Preschool project update – Erika - exhibition done at Shadelands. The collection will be moved to City Hall with a reception on June 11 at 11:00 am. Maile wants CAG to provide snacks.

Meals on wheels – Barbara – The glazing event went well. The 7 pieces (3 bowls/4 vases) were picked up by Meals on Wheels for their fundraising auction.

Tools Sales - discussion about payment options. QR code is an option with Square, but hard to manage the 3.3% fees. Venmo is a popular payment method, but it requires a phone number. Google Phone was discussed, but quick research in the meeting indicated that sometimes Venmo rejects google number. It might be possible to have a second venmo account on the same phone number. Julie Dandliker to research this further.
